

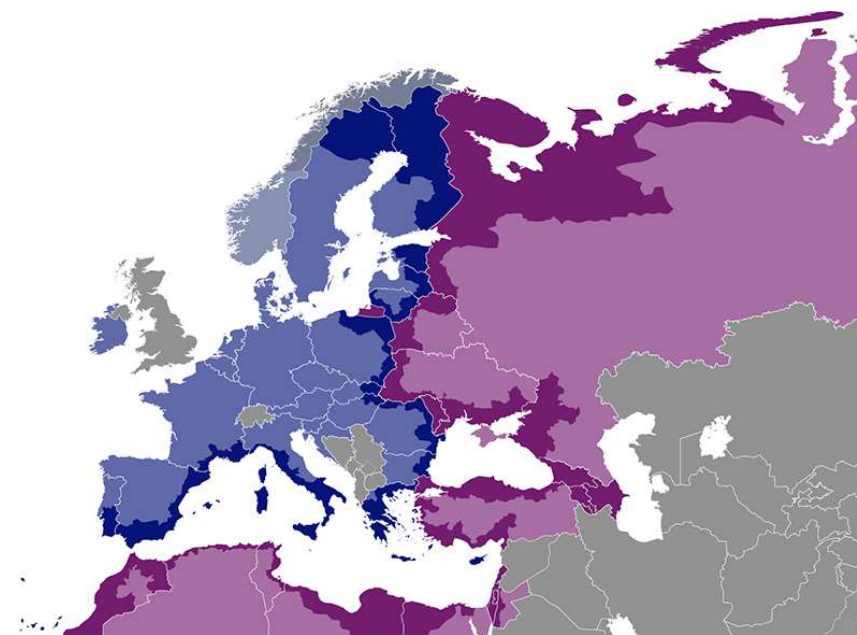

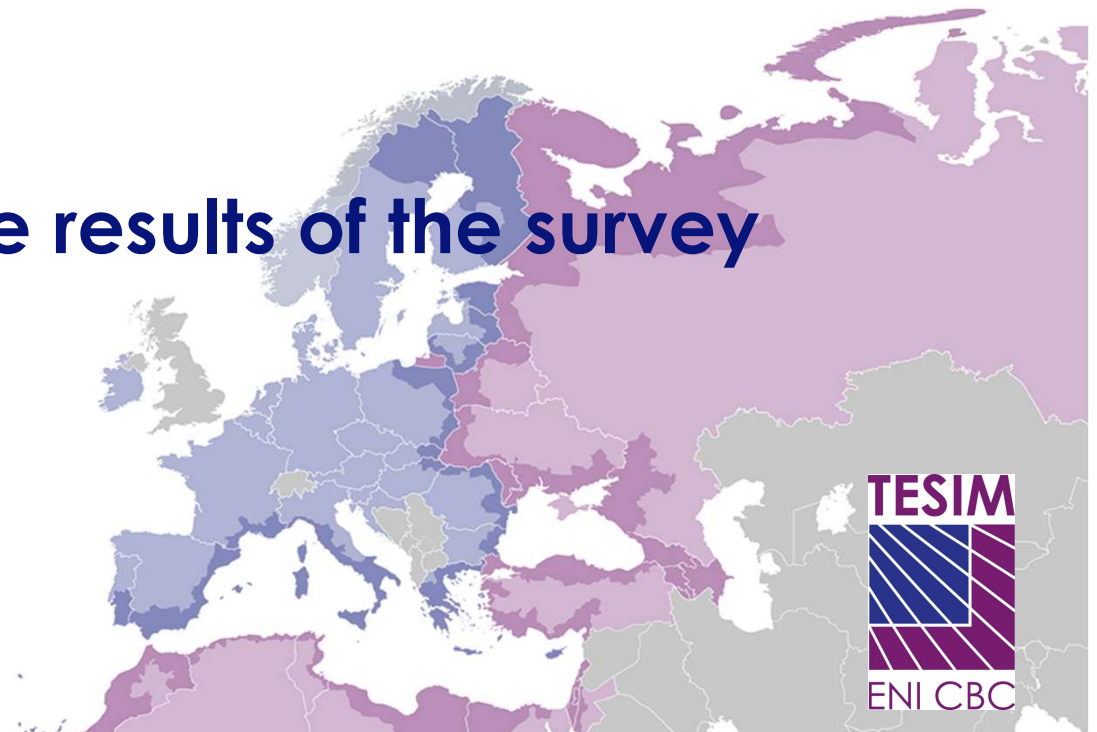

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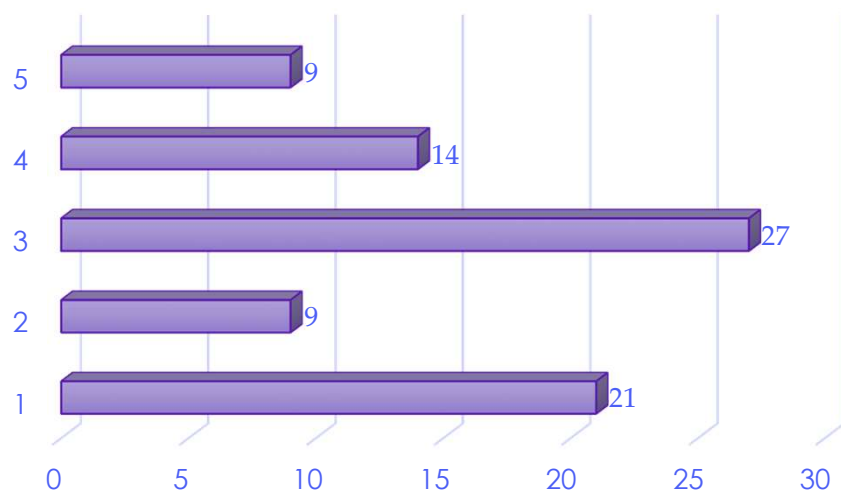


Synthesis of the results of the survey

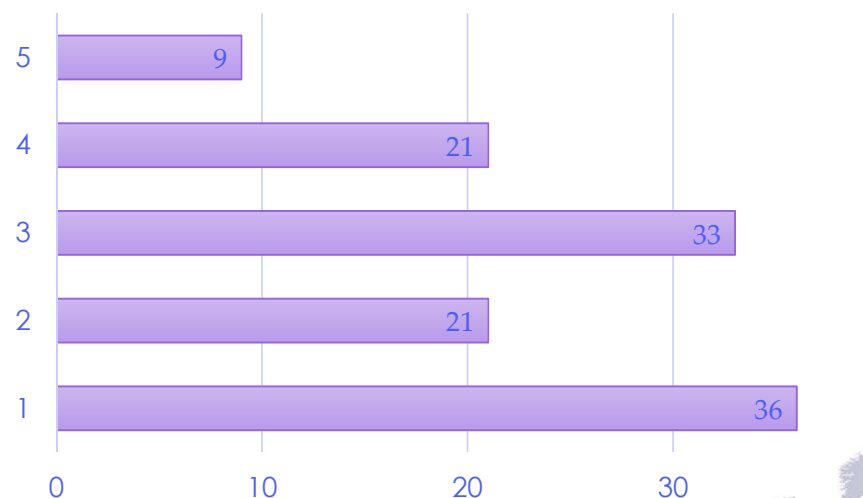


Key messages from the survey

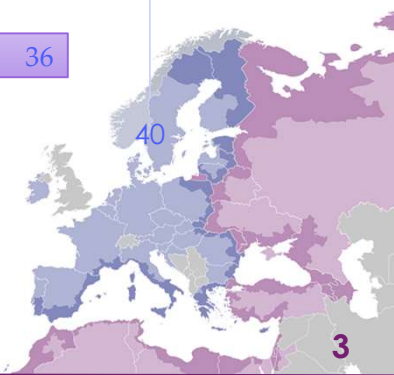
Result indicators - Overall



Output indicators - Overall

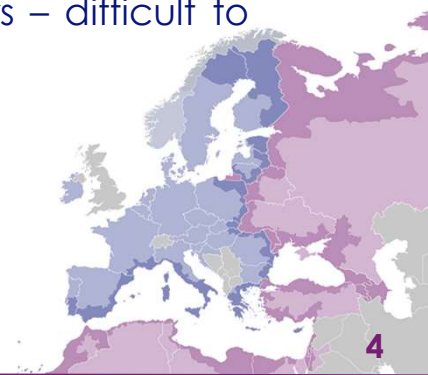


10 responses, 7 Programmes participated



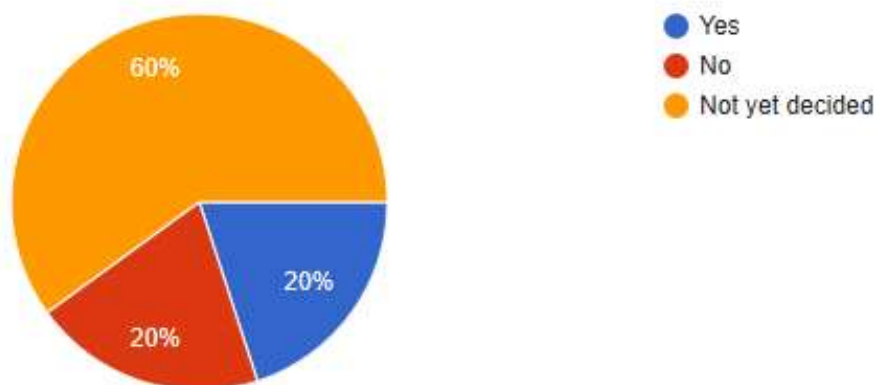
Key messages from the survey 2

- ❑ Mild dissatisfaction with the indicators in use for the 2014-2020 programming period
- ❑ Result indicators:
 - ❑ An interest in ownership and sustainability appears: the indicator with the best score is 'Number of organisations that have established or maintained durable cross-border cooperation links'
 - ❑ Lower interest in measuring agreements between PA and other stakeholders – difficult to reach?
- ❑ Output indicators:
 - ❑ Focus on non-governmental actors
 - ❑ Difficulties / Irrelevance in measuring social services?



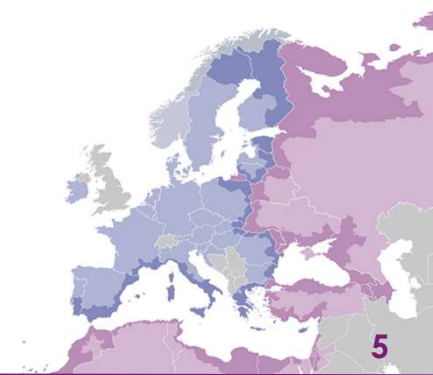
Key messages from the survey 3

- ❑ Indicators from funded projects: only two contributions (Qualitative indicators that can measure change in behaviour, satisfaction and emancipation; joint efforts in [fields])
- ❑ Do you plan to work on Policy Objective 4 "More social Europe" for your NEXT strategy ?

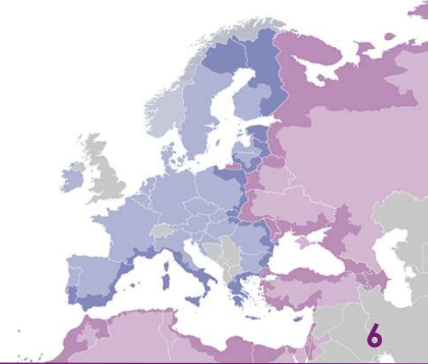


Kolartic and Med Sea

- ❑ What is the change expected for beneficiaries?
=> **Result indicators**
- ❑ What will be the relevant actions to support beneficiaries to reach that change?
=> identify actions and **output indicators**
- ❑ Greater relevance of **common indicators**
- ❑ Target setting may be **challenging**

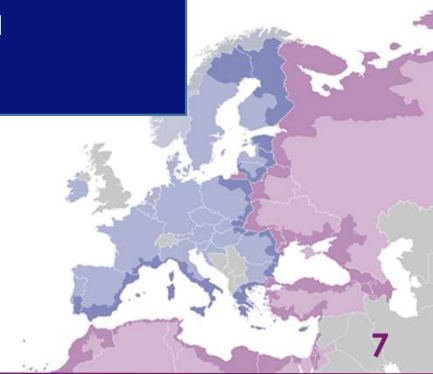


Output common indicators

- RCO 69 - Capacity of supported health care infrastructure

Result common indicators

- RCR 72 - People with access to improved health care services
- RCR 73 - Annual number of persons using the health care facilities supported
- RCR 74 - Annual number of persons using the social care facilities supported
- RCR 75 - Average response time for medical emergencies in the area supported

Common output and result indicators for Interreg

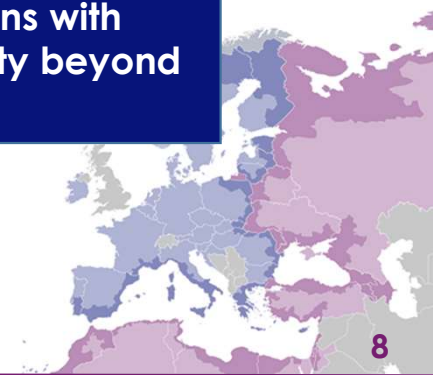


Output common indicators

- RCO 85 - Participants in joint training schemes
- RCO 96 – Legal or administrative obstacles identified
- RCO 87 - Organisations cooperating across borders
- RCO 89 - Projects across borders to improve multilevel governance

Result common indicators

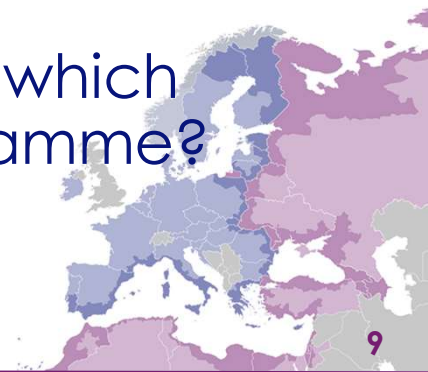
- RCR 79 - Joint strategies/ action plans taken up by organisations at/ after project completion
- RCR 80 - Joint pilot activities taken up or up-scaled by organisations at/ after project completion
- RCR 82 - Legal or administrative obstacles addressed or alleviated
- RCR 86 - Stakeholders/ institutions with enhanced cooperation capacity beyond national borders

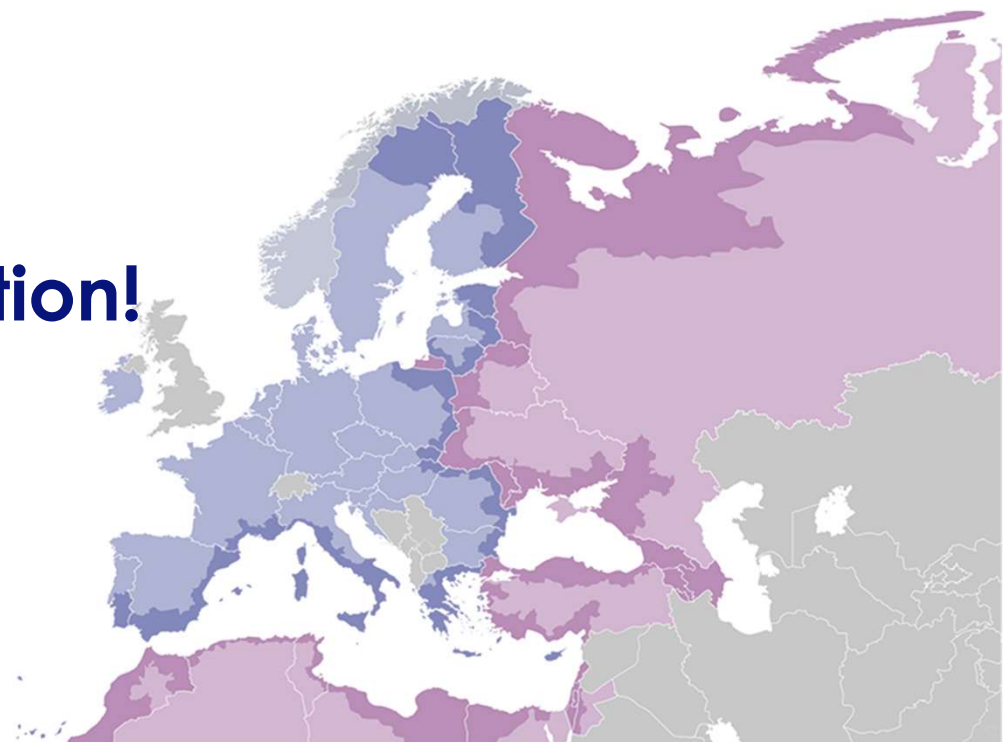
